This is an application u/s 482 of B.N.S.S. filed by the petitioner namely, Indrajit Bag in c/w Keshpur P.S Case No. 195/2026 dtd 23.05.2026 u/s. 85/115(2)/117(2)/74/3(5) BNS & 3/4 D.P. Act.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioner/petitioners submitted that no bail application has either been filed before any Higher Court or any such bail petition has been rejected.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioner submits that the petitioner and his wife/ defacto-complainant have been residing peacefully as the dispute between them has been amicably settled. Therefore, he prays for anticipatory bail on any terms and conditions.

Defacto-complainant caused her appearance through the Advocate Sri Subhojit Dan. Ld. Advocate for the defacto-complainant raises no objection if the petitioner is granted anticipatory bail. A petition supported by an affidavit is filed to that effect.

Ld. P.P in-charge produced the case diary and leaves the adjudication of the case to the discretion of the Court by pointing out the matters available in the case diary.

Heard the Ld. Advocate and Ld. P.P. in-charge.

Perused the petition, CD and other materials in case record.

Considering the change of circumstances, this Court is inclined to grant the anticipatory bail of the petitioner. Hence, the petition for anticipatory bail is considered and allowed.

In the event of arrest the petitioner, namely, Indrajit Bag may find bail of Rs.2,000/- with 2 sureties of Rs.1,000/- each subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting officer and with usual condition as laid down u/s 482(2) B.N.S.S.

Misc case is disposed of. CD/TCR, if any, be returned.
