Order No. 06 dated 13.08.2026

This is an application u/s 482 of B.N.S.S. filed by the petitioners namely, Dulal Bag @ Nandadulal Bag and 02 others in c/w Pingla P.S Case No. 116/2026 dtd 06.06.2026 u/s. 329(4)/115(2)/117(2)/109/3(5) of BNS.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioner/petitioners submitted that no bail application has either been filed before any Higher Court or any such bail petition has been rejected.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioners submits that these petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case and they have nothing to do of the alleged offence. Therefore, he prays for anticipatory bail on any terms and conditions.

On the other hand, Ld. P.P. produced the case diary and draws attention of this Court to the injury report and the statement of the witnesses recorded u/s 183 of B.N.S.S. Ld. P.P. opposes the bail application.

Heard both sides.

Perused the case diary.

Upon perusal of the materials available therein, including the injury report and statement of the witnesses recorded u/s 183 of B.N.S.S. it appears that although the victim sustained serious injuries but there is no direct involvement of the petitioner in the alleged offence. Considering the materials available therein and having heard the submission of both sides this Court finds that there is no sufficient reason to hold that custodial interrogation of the petitioners is required for investigation. This Court further finds that it is a fit case to grant anticipatory bail. Hence, the petition for anticipatory bail is considered and allowed.

In the event of arrest the petitioners, Dulal Bag @ Nandadulal Bag, Sanjib Bag and Sourav Bag may find bail of Rs.2,000/- each with 2 sureties of Rs.1,000/- each subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting officer and with usual condition as laid down u/s 482(2) B.N.S.S.

Misc case is disposed of. CD/TCR, if any, be returned.
