However, it appears to this court as per directions of Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court in case titled **Jasveer Singh Versus State of Punjab and another CRM-M-44143-2020(O&M)**, the notice to complainant is not necessary whenever untrace report is filed in a case where the FIR is registered against unknown persons i.e. the identity of the accused is neither known nor disclosed. As per the directions of Hon'ble High Court such cases can be disposed off directly by the court concerned. Hence, keeping in view the said direction. Scrutiny of file shows that the police has made ample efforts to trace the offender but remained unsuccessful. The untrace report in the present case is hereby accepted. File be sent to the office of Superintendent of Police, Rohtak for future purpose. **Complainant is also at liberty to file the protest petition.** However, the file shall not be destroyed without prior permission to this Court and shall be put before this Court as and when accused is apprehended. Case property may be disposed off as per rules.
