This is an application u/s 482 of B.N.S.S. filed by the petitioner namely, Sk Sujauddin @ Sk Sajedul Rahaman in c/w Debra P.S Case No.333/2026 dtd 20.06.2026 u/s. 62/64(1)/329(4)/351(2)/3(5) of BNS.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioner/petitioners submitted that no bail application has either been filed before any Higher Court or any such bail petition has been rejected.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioner submitted that this case was initiated u/s 64(1)/329(4) and other Sections of B.N.S. against this petitioner. There is no allegation against him that attracts Section 64(1) of B.N.S. This case was started on 20.06.2026 and investigation is almost complete, so at this stage, petitioner may be granted anticipatory bail on any condition.

Ld. P.P. opposed the bail prayer by submitting that allegation against the petitioner is serious in nature and investigation is on progress.

Heard the Ld. Advocate and Ld. P.P.

Perused the petition, CD and other materials in case record.

On perusal of the C.D. I find that after 04.07.2026 there is no progress in the investigation by the police and the allegation levelled against the present petitioner does not attract Section 64(1) of B.N.S. So, considering the materials in C.D., I am inclined to allow the anticipatory bail application of the present petitioner. Hence, the petition for anticipatory bail is considered and allowed.

In the event of arrest the petitioner named above may find bail of Rs. 2,000/- with 2 sureties of Rs.1,000/- each, with condition to meet the I.O. once in a fortnight till submission of charge sheet, subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting officer and with usual condition as laid down u/s 482(2) B.N.S.S.

Misc case is disposed of. CD/TCR, if any, be returned.
