This is an application u/s 482 of B.N.S.S. filed by the petitioners namely, Suman Adak and another in c/w Chandrakona P.S Case No. 242/2026 dated 17.06.2026 u/s. 329(4)/115(2)/117(2)/79/109(1)/74/351(2)/3(5) of BNS.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioner/petitioners submitted that no bail application has either been filed before any Higher Court or any such bail petition has been rejected.

Ld. Advocate prefers not to press the bail petition for accused petitioners no. 1, namely, Suman Adak. Accordingly, the bail petition for the above named accused petitioner stands dismissed, being not pressed.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioners submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and the offence that the accused is alleged to have committed, does not attract the Section 109(1) of B.N.S. Therefore, he prays for anticipatory bail on any terms and conditions.

Ld. P.P. in-charge produces the case diary and leaves the adjudication of the case to the discretion of the Court by pointing out the matters available in the case diary.

Heard the Ld. Advocate and Ld. P.P.

Perused the petition, CD and other materials in case record.

Perused the statement recorded u/s. 180 of the BNSS, especially that of the injured person at page 15 of the CD.

Perused the injury report at page 21 of the CD.

Prima facie, it appears that there are insufficient incriminating materials against the present accused / petitioner No.2 being a female accused person.

As such, considering the materials available on record, in my opinion, custodial detention for the purpose of interrogation of the petitioner is not necessary. Hence, prayer for anticipatory bail is considered and allowed.

In the event of arrest the petitioner, namely, Smt. Maya Adak may find bail of Rs. 2,000/- with 2 sureties of Rs.1,000/- each subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting officer and with usual condition as laid down u/s 482(2) B.N.S.S.

Misc case is disposed of. CD/TCR, if any, be returned.
