This is an application u/s 482 of B.N.S.S. filed by the petitioners namely, Khalafat Mandal and 7 others in c/w Garhbeta P.S Case No. 280/2026 dated 17.06.2026 u/s. 329(4)/119(2)/117(2)/109/351(2)(3)/3(5) BNS.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioner/petitioners submitted that no bail application has either been filed before any Higher Court or any such bail petition has been rejected.

The defacto-complainant appears today before the Court. She swears an affidavit stating her objection if bail is granted to the accused petitioners. Let the same be kept with the record.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioners submits that these petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case and they have nothing to do with the alleged offence. Therefore, he prays for anticipatory bail on any terms and conditions.

Ld. P.P. in-charge produced the case diary and leaves the adjudication of the case to the discretion of the Court by pointing out the matters available in the case diary.

Heard the Ld. Advocate and Ld. P.P. in-charge.

Perused the petition, CD and other materials in case record.

Regard being had to the facts and circumstances of the case and bearing in mind the extent of complicity of the present accused persons, as transpires from the materials available in the Case Diary, more particularly, the statement of injured recorded u/s 180 of B.N.S.S, medical papers and stage of investigation, I am of the considered view that this is a fit case to admit the present accused persons with an order of pre-arrest bail. Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail stands allowed.

Accordingly, in the event of arrest, the petitioners as named above in c/w the above noted P.S. case, shall be released on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 3,000/- each with two sureties of Rs. 1,500/- each on condition that the accused petitioners no.1, 2, 3, 4, 7 and 8 will meet with the I.O once in a week till completion of investigation and the accused petitioners No. 5 and 6 will meet with the I.O as and when so requires for the purpose of investigation, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.

If released on bail, the petitioners are directed to comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 482(2) B.N.S.S.

Misc case is disposed of. CD/TCR, if any, be returned.
