Having regard to under section 13B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 and on the motion of both the parties made today after six months from the date of presentation of the aforesaid case, now it appears to me that the Matrimonial Tie between the parties has been broken to such an extent that their co-existence is practically impossible and as such I am inclined to pass order accordingly.

In the result, the suit succeeds. C.F paid is correct.

Ordered

that the Matrimonial Suit be and the same is hereby allowed on mutual consent in terms of the petition U/sec. 13B of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 and the marriage solemnized between the parties on 20.08.2020 according to Hindu Rites and Customs and the said marriage was registered on 03.10.2020 under the provisions of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 stands dissolved by a decree of divorce on mutual consent with effect from this date of order.
