Today is fixed for hearing of injunction application on ex-parte.

Plaintiff is present through his Ld. Advocate.

Heard Ld. Advocate for the Plaintiff.

This is a suit for declaration, recovery of khas possession and permanent injunction in respect of two scheduled suit property namely *Ka & Kha*. The plaintiff (represented by his mother) sought for injunction in respect of Ka scheduled property only.

Plaintiff(represented by his mother) place his reliance upon the original copy of Gift Deed being no. I 2833 for the year 2018, digital certified copy of L.R. khatian no.280 for the mouza-Tentuldanga having J.L. no.709,certified copies of Deed nos 5782 for the year 1992 and 835 for the 1980, photocopies of complain letter to Chandrakona Road Police Beat House under Garhbeta P.S. dated 30.08.2022, original rent receipt no. 6622544, certified copies of R.S. khatian no.126, for the mouza-Tentuldanga having J.L. no.709 and web copy of plot information.

It transpires from the record that vide Order no.2 dated 02.09.2022 an interlocutory order has been passed restraining the defendant 1 to 4 from disturbing the possession of the plaintiff (represented by his mother) over the ***Ka*** schedule property and from changing the nature and character of the same.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the plaintiff.

Perused the application and other materials on record.

Considering all the above facts the interlocutory order as passed by this Court vide Order no. 2 dated 02.09.2022 is hereby made absolute and extended till the disposal of the suit.

The application for temporary injunction is thus disposed of exparte.
