This order of mine shall dispose off an application for bail moved by applicant Sunita through her counsel Sh. Narinder Kumar, Advocate.

In the application it is averred that the accused was arrested in the present case on 26.06.2020. Present case has been falsely planted on the accused. Further, submitted that since recovery has already been effected and the presentation of challan will take time, hence, prayed that accused be released on bail.

Upon notice, learned APP for the State, has opposed the bail application on the ground that accused has committed serious offence. Hence, she does not deserve the concession of bail and prayed for dismissal of the present bail application.

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Arguments heard. Perusal of file transpires that the present FIR has been registered against the accused under Section 61 of Punjab Excise Act and 40 plastic cann each containing 34,820 ML illicit liquor were recovered from the accused. No doubt accused has been in custody since 27.06.2020. However, keeping in view heavy recovery effected from the accused, I do not find it appropriate to grant the concession of bail to accused in this case. As such, the present bail application is hereby dismissed and disposed off. Ahlmad is directed to attach the papers with the main file.
