Petition dated: 07.07.2026 filed U/s.483(1)(b) of BNSS to relax the condition.

This petition is coming on this day for hearing before me, in the presence of Thiru.P.Eswaramoorthy, Advocate for the petitioners and Thiru.S.Arunkumar, the Public Prosecutor for the respondent and upon hearing both sides arguments, this Court passed the following :

ORDER

This petition has been filed by the Petitioners/A1 to A6 under S.483(1)(b) BNSS seeking to relax the bail condition already imposed by this Court in CrI MP No.1119/2026 dated 05.08.2026.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners has submitted that the 3rd petitioner is working in a private company at Vellore, the 5th petitioner is working as a Physical Education Teacher in Kongu National Matriculation School, Nanjanapuram, Erode and the 6th petitioner is having 1 ½ year old child and the 1st, 3rd to 6th petitioners are complying with the condition before the respondent police daily at 10.00 a.m., from 07.08.2026 and it is very difficult for them to complying with the conditions before the respondent police and they prayed to relax the condition in toto.

The learned Public Prosecutor has submitted that the petitioners are complying with the conditions before the respondent police only on 07.08.2026. Hence, he strongly opposed to relax the condition in toto.

Heard both sides. Considering the nature of the offence, Considering the fact that the petitioners have complied the conditions before the respondent police only on 07.08.2026 and considering the strong objection raised by the prosecution, this court is not inclined to allow the petition.

In the result, this petition is hereby dismissed.
