1. Vide this order, I shall dispose off the present bail application filed on behalf of accused/applicant Darshan in the above noted case.

2. Notice of the bail application has been given to the State through learned Additional Public Prosecutor. The record of the case has also been perused.

3. The Learned counsel for the applicant has contended that the applicant could not appear in this court on 12.07.2018 because he was confined in District Jail Mansa in case FIR NO.101 dated 01.07.2018, under Section 15 of the ND&Ps Act, P.S.Sadar Mansa. That the absence of the accused is not intentional but due to the above said reasons. A prayer for grant of bail has been made.

4. On the contrary learned Additional Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail application.

5. I have heard the submissions of both the side and have also

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perused the record.

6. From the perusal of the record it is revealed that the trial is pending before this Court and the accused absented from the proceedings on 12.07.2018 and vide order of the same date this Court has cancelled the bail order of the accused and also canceled the bail bonds and surety bonds of the accused, forfeited the same and ordered the issuance of arrest warrants against the accused. Thereafter he was produced in the Court by way of production warrants as he was confined in District Jail Mansa in some other case.. Accused is in custody and he must have learnt a lesson for absconding the Court proceedings. There is no previous history of absenteeism of the applicant as per the record. No useful purpose would be served by detaining the accused in custody for indefinite period rather it will be burden on the State exchequer. Therefore, without commenting on the merits of the case, the application is allowed and the applicant is ordered to be released on bail, subject to furnishing bail bonds in the sum of ₹ 50,000/- with one surety in the like amount. Papers be attached with the main file.
