	20.12.2022	A Surrender cum bail petition on behalf of accused persons namely 1. Ramnandan Sao S/o Jagdish Sao, 2. Raju @ Raja Kumar S/o Laxman Sao and 3. Kishori Sao S/o Late Kashi Sao in connection with Pratappur P.S. Case No. 147/2022 has been filed and pressed today. The copy of the same has been served to learned P.P. From perusal of record it appears that this accused petitioners are wanted in this case; and accused/petitioners namely 1. Ramnandan Sao, 2. Raju @ Raja Kumar and 3. Kishori Sao are taken into judicial custody. The learned counsel for the accused/petitioners moved the bail petition and submitted that petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in this case and earlier no any bail petition was either filed or moved in any court and the story narrated in the FIR is false and fabricated and the above petitioners have deposited the fine amount of Rs. 10,500/- by Ramnandan Sao, fine amount of Rs. 10,500/- by Raju @ Raja Kumar and fine amount of Rs. 10,500/- by Kishori Sao before the Electricity Department and original copy of receipts have also been annexed with the bail petition hence accused/petitioners may kindly be enlarged on bail. Learned P.P did not raise any objection and submitted that it is a case of Electricity theft and the electricity department has imposed the fine amount of Rs. 10,500/- by Ramnandan Sao, fine amount of Rs. 10,500/- by Raju @ Raja Kumar and fine amount of Rs. 10,500/- by Kishori Sao which have been deposited by the above accused/ petitioners. Heard learned counsel for the accused/petitioners as well as learned P.P. for the State and also perused the case record. From perusal of record it appears that FIR has been registered for the offence U/s 135,138 of Jharkhand Electricity Act against total eight accused persons including the present accused/petitioners with the allegation against the accused/petitioners that they have committed theft of Electricity and have been imposed to the accused/ petitioners by the Electricity Department which have already been deposited by the accused/ petitioners vide receipt no. 503444 of

In view the aforesaid mentioned facts and circumstances, the accused/petitioners namely 1. Ramnandan Sao, 2. Raju @ Raja Kumar and 3. Kishori Sao are directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with one surety each. Accordingly this Miscellaneous Criminal Application filed on behalf of accused/petitioners namely 1. Ramnandan Sao, 2. Raju @ Raja Kumar and 3. Kishori Sao is accordingly disposed off.
