Jaswinder Singh Vs. Arwinder Singh etc.

Present :- Mr. A.K.Vermani, Adv. counsel for the applicant/accused.

- The present bail application has been moved on behalf of applicants/accused Arwinder Singh and Amarjit Kaur under section 438 Cr.P.C in complaint case titled as 'Jaswinder Singh Vs. Manwinder Singh etc.' wherein the applicants/accused have been summoned to face trial u/s 148,149,326,324,323,452,504,506 of IPC.
- Record received and perused.
- Heard. It has been contended by Ld. Counsel for the applicants that the applicants are innocent and they have not committed offence. The complainant has filed false and frivolous complaint against the applicants. It is a complaint case and custodial interrogation of the applicants is not required at all. He further argued that the alleged injuries attributed to the applicants are on the non-vital part of the body and there is considerable delay in filing the complaint. He further argued that the petitioners shall abide by the terms and

conditions of bail. On the contrary, Ld. Counsel for the complainant opposed the bail application on the score that applicants have committed the serious offence and they do not deserve the concession of bail.

- In the instant case, since the applicants/accused have been summoned by Ld. Trial Court in private complaint as such the custodial interrogation is apparently not required. The conclusion of trial would take long time. Nothing is to be recovered from the applicants/accused and even otherwise, the offences under which the applicants have been summoned are triable by Magistrate. As such the applicants/accused are directed to appear in the Ld. Trial court within 20 days and upon their doing so, they are ordered to be released on interim bail on furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Illaqa/Duty Magistrate subject to conditions laid down in section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. They will not threat, promise or induce the prosecution witnesses. They will not leave India without prior permission of the court, will appear in the court on each and every date of hearing and will not indulge in such activities in future. File of lower court be returned alongwith copy

of this order. Report of lower court be called for 29.05.2018.
