Arguments on bail application, heard. Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused has argued that applicant-accused is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in the present case. He has nothing to do with the above said offence. The facts mention in the FIR are totally wrong, false and frivolous and the police has falsely implicated the applicant-accused. He further argued that the alleged recovery, if any is fabricated one. *He further argued that no such application has been decided or pending in any competent Court of India.*

On the other hand, Ld. APP for the state submitted that offence is serious, so application may be dismissed.

Considered. The accused is in custody since his arrest. The presentation of challan and its trial will take long time and no useful purpose will be served to keep the accused behind the bars. Keeping in

view the cust not ody of the applicant/accused and above said circumstances, the bail application is allowed. Applicant/accused Soni S/o Sardari Masih is admitted on bail on furnishing bail bonds in sum of Rs. 20,000/ with one surety in the like amount with an undertaking not to temper with the evidence of the prosecution and to appear in the Court on each and every date of hearing and not to leave the country without prior permission of the Court. Requisite bail bonds/surety bonds are not furnished today.
