J U D G E M E N T

(Delivered on this the 30th day of January of the year 2024)

1. This judgment shall dispose of the above mentioned Special Inventory Proceedings, which was instituted upon the death of Ms. Kalavati Gurudas Rivankar alias Vaijanti Rivonkar alias Kalavati Gurudas Revankar. This Inventory was filed by the husband of the Estate Leaver.

2. Vide Order passed at exhibit 1, the Applicant was appointed as the Head of the Family. The Head of the Family was then administered the oath of office. He then filed his Statement on Oath, wherein he set out that the Estate Leaver passed away leaving him behind as his widower and moiety holder. He further set out that the Estate Leaver died intestate. He set out the names of all the heirs i.e. the six children of the Estate Leaver. One of the children i.e. a daughter is unmarried. The names and details of the spouses of the other five children was also set out in the Statement. He further set out that the heirs named in the Statement are the only and universal heirs of the Estate Leaver. He further set out that the Estate Leaver

did not leave behind any other heirs, creditors or legatees, who could claim the said inheritance.

3. Later the same Advocate filed vakalatnama for all the Interested Parties.

4. The List of Assets was filed at exhibit 10. Vide application at exhibit 11, by consent, the stage of valuation was waived. The Final List of Assets was drawn. The same can be found at exhibit 12.

5. A Conference of Interested Parties was sought. The same was then conducted. A plan was drawn during the said Conference, which forms part and parcel of the Minutes of Conference. The Minutes of Conference along with the enclosed plan are at exhibit 14.

6. The Scheme of Partition was filed, along with the same plan. The same is at exhibit 13.

7. The Provisional Chart of Allotment was filed, at exhibit 14. On that basis, the Final Chart of Allotment was drawn. The same is at exhibit 15. The learned Advocate informed the Court that the Head of the Family and all Interested Parties have no objection to the same.

8. The necessary stamp duty was also paid, as required under the Goa Succession, Special Notaries and Inventory Proceedings Act, 2012.

9. I have perused the records in the case and in view of the case set out and procedure followed, the assets listed in the Final List of Assets (exhibit 12) are hereby allotted in terms of the Final Chart of Partition (exhibit 15).

Decree to be drawn accordingly.
