**Bail application Under Section 439 Cr.PC.**

**ORDER:**

1. By this order, this Court intends to dispose off the present bail application under Section 439 Cr.PC having been filed by applicant Sona Singh @ Soni.
2. Notice of the bail application was served upon the State through learned Additional PP alongwith copy of bail application, who received the same, appeared and contested the bail application on merits. Police record was requisitioned which has been received and perused.
3. I have heard the respective contentions of both the learned Advocates and have perused the record with their able assistance.
4. As per allegations levelled by complainant Raj Kumar, it was

on 03.08.2023 at about 10:15 PM that while he was travelling on his motorcycle in the area of GT road Jalalabad a little ahead of FCI godowns, he was intercepted by unidentified persons riding on two motorcycles who were possessing sharp edged weapons. After intercepting him, they committed snatching of two mobile phones i.e. Oppo F-5 and Vivo V20, Rs.8300/- cash, Driving license, three debit cards, three Credit Cards, one silver coin, PAN card, Aadhar card, RC of motorcycle bearing No.PB05-AL-8351 and other important documents. It further reveals that during the course of further investigation, while the hunt for apprehending the assailants was on, the complainant suffered supplementary statement as reflected in DDR No.52 dated 07.08.2023 by naming the present applicant as one of the snatchers. The allegation of complainant stands prima facie corroborated with the fact that after his apprehension, recovery of one mobile phone make Oppo F5, two debit cards and one credit card belonging to the complainant was effected from the possession of applicant. The investigation of the case is still going on as such, release of the applicant in view of the seriousness of allegations is likely to adversely affect the progress of investigation and thereafter examination of the material witnesses. Moreover, the incidents of snatching are on rise in the society as such, release of the applicant on bail is not justified. Hence, the bail application stands dismissed being without merits. File be consigned to the record room.
