This is an application u/s 482 of B.N.S.S. filed by the petitioners namely, Atanu Bar and 02 others in c/w Kharagpur(T) P.S. Case No.257/2026 dtd 20.05.2026 u/s. 85/115(2)/117(2)/108/3(5) BNS.

Ld. advocate for the petitioner/petitioners submitted that no bail application has either been filed before any Higher Court or any such bail petition has been rejected.

Heard the Ld. Advocate and Ld. P.P. in-charge.

Perused the petition, CD and other materials in case record.

It appears from the record that petitioner nos. 1 & 2 are the in-laws of the victim and there are general allegations against the petitioner nos.2 & 3. Petitioner no.1 is the husband of the victim. It is true that police miss-coded section 108 of BNS, though the victim/wife is still alive. But the allegation against the husband is that due to his torture the victim lady tried to commit suicide. So, considering the materials available in the CD I am not inclined to allow the anticipatory bail prayer of the petitioner no.1. Hence, the anticipatory bail petition against the **petitioner no.1** stands **rejected**.

However, I am inclined to allow the anticipatory bail prayer of the petitioner nos.2 & 3. Hence, prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner nos. 2 & 3 is considered and allowed.

In the event of arrest the petitioner nos. 2 & 3 may find bail of Rs.2,000/- each with 2 sureties of Rs.1,000/- each subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting officer and with usual condition as laid down u/s 482(2) B.N.S.S.

Misc case is disposed of. CD/TCR, if any, be returned.
