ORDER:

This order of mine shall dispose of the bail application
filed by applicant-accused under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR
No.316 dated 05.12.2019, under Sections 307, 452, 324, 323, 325,
326, 450, 427 read with Section 34 of the IPC registered at P.S.
Lehra, District Sangrur.

2. Notice of the bail application was given to the Ld. Addl. Public Prosecutor for the State and original file has also been requisitioned.

3. I have heard learned counsel for the applicant-accused and learned Addl. Public Prosecutor for the State and have gone through the record very carefully.

4. It has been contended by learned counsel for the applicant-accused that the applicant-accused is an innocent person and has not committed any offence. The applicant-accused has been falsely implicated in the present case. None of the injuries on the person of complainant was declared dangerous to life by the Doctor. He has further submitted that complainant has concealed the facts regarding his relationship with the applicant/accused and non effecting of any partition of the joint land between them. The applicant-accused is in judicial custody since 14.01.2020. The challan has already been presented and conclusion of trial is likely to take time. Therefore, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the applicant-accused behind bars for an indefinite period. A prayer has been made to admit the applicant-accused to regular bail.

5. Ld. Public Prosecutor for the State, on the other hand, has opposed the bail application by submitting that the offences committed by the applicant-accused are serious in nature and keeping in view the gravity of the offences committed by the

applicant-accused, the applicant-accused is not entitled to the benefit of regular bail. Hence, a prayer has been made to dismiss the bail application filed by the applicant-accused.

6. From the perusal of the file, it transpires that the present case FIR has been registered against the applicant-accused and others on the basis of statement of complainant Babu Singh on the allegations that on 05.12.2019 at about 11:00 AM. the applicant/accused armed with Dah alongwith two unknown persons armed with gandassas caused injuries on the left leg, right shoulder and head of complainant Babu Singh with their respective weapons with an intention to kill him. The injury attributed to applicant/accused was allegedly caused by him on the left knee and leg of the complainant with iron Dah, which is on non-vital part of the body of the complainant. The injuries No.1 and 5 caused on the person of the complainant are grievous and injuries No.2,3 and 4 are simple in nature. There is no medical opinion by the doctor concerned as to whether any injury is dangerous to life. The applicant-accused is in judicial custody since 14.01.2020. Challan has already been presented in this case. The conclusion of trial is likely to take time. No useful purpose would be served by detaining the applicant-accused behind bars for an indefinite period. Thus, without commenting on the merits of case and keeping in view the totality of facts and circumstances of the case, the applicant/accused

is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing a bail bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of Ilaqa/duty Magistrate with an undertaking to appear in the Court on each and every date of hearing, not to leave the country without the prior permission of the Court and shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence. The bail application stands allowed accordingly. The bail application file be consigned to the Record Room, Sangrur.
