O R D E R:-

This order of mine shall decide this application for pre-arrest bail under section 482 BNSS, filed in the above noted FIR on behalf of applicant, on the allegations that he is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present case. He is 69 years of age and is a respectable person. He usually come to the Courts for identifying the

sureties . He is well acquainted with the people of Ferozepur district and when somebody comes to him, he checks the details of residence, parentage etc. before endorsing their identification. In this case also, documents concerning bail bonds were of Ramandeep Singh son of Jasbir Singh, resident of Hira Mandi, Ferozepur City. Applicant signed in good faith on the documents. There was no criminal intention in the mind of applicant to cheat the Court. Applicant/accused is ready to join investigation. His custodial interrogation is not required. Hence, it is prayed that the application be allowed and applicant be given the concession of pre-arrest bail.

2. Notice of bail application was issued to State and Sh. Dalip Kumar, Learned Public Prosecutor put in appearance on behalf of State. Record has also been requisitioned.

3. I have heard arguments of learned counsel for applicant and learned Public Prosecutor for State and have gone through the record.

4. As per report of filing branch clerk, no bail application filed by applicant/accused is pending in the Hon'ble High Court. He has attached on record copy of report downloaded from the website of Punjab and Haryana High Court.

5. Case against applicant/accused, Ramandeep Singh and Robin was registered on the letter of Ms. Balwinder Kaur Dhaliwal, JMIC,

Ferozepur that Ramesh @ Mesha was granted bail in a criminal case by Learned Judge, Special Court, Ferozepur. Ramandeep Singh alongwith Tarlok Singh *Nambardar* and applicant/ accused came to the Court of Judicial Magistrate in order to furnish bail bonds and surety bonds in compliance with the order dated 24.01.2024 passed by learned Judge, Special Court, Ferozepur. On inquiry, Reader of the Court found that Ramandeep Singh has furnished fake surety in connivance with Tarlok Singh and Robin by forging his *Aadhar Card* and thereby committed an offence punishable under sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 read with 34 IPC. When learned Judicial Magistrate was confirming about the fake *Aadhar Card* being produced by Ramandeep Singh, Tarlok Singh *Nambardar* and Robin ran away from the Court and thereafter, on the application of learned Judicial Magistrate, present case was registered.

6. Learned counsel for applicant/accused that applicant/accused has identified Ramandeep Singh as surety in the Court and he was not aware of the fact that Ramandeep Singh has forged *Aadhar Card* or property documents. He appeared only for identification of Ramandeep Singh. So, his custodial interrogation is not required.

7. I have gone through the file carefully. The case of the prosecution is that Ramandeep Singh has submitted forged *Aadhar*

Card and copy of *jamabandi*. Applicant/accused has identified Ramandeep Singh being identifier. So, his custodial interrogation is not required. Considering all these facts, applicant/accused is directed to join investigation. In case he is required to be arrested, he be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. The applicant shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 482(2) of BNSS.

8. Now file be put up on 10.09.2024.
