

GURDEEP SINGH VS State of Punjab etc.

Report from concerned Doctor through Superintendent, Central Jail, Patiala has been received. As per report received from the Dr. Paramveer Singh, Medical Officer (PSY), Central Jail, Patiala, the applicant-accused Gurdeep Singh son of Labh Singh has no history of any chronic medical illness. He comes occasionally to Jail Hospital for which he is given symptomatic treatment. He came to jail hospital with complaint of pain in neck and pain in chest in the month of May. He was examined and investigated and symptomatic treatment was given. It is further reported that as pain did not subside he was sent on emergency guard to Government Rajindra Hospital, Patiala on 30.5.2024 where he was admitted in department of medicine from 30.5.2024 to 4.6.2024 where USG w/a and KUB was also done which showed (N) LV systolic function and LVEF 60%. He was diagnosed as having non cardiac chest pain? Gastritis and was given symptomatic treatment. He was thoroughly investigated with blood tests. No major change was noted. It is further reported that applicant-accused is now medically stable.

2. On the other hand, learned counsel for the applicant has placed on record application moved by wife of applicant before Dr. Adish Goyal MBBS, MD-FM Medico-Legal Expert who has checked the medical record of Gurdeep Singh as produced by his wife and opined that patient needs further evaluation from higher centre having super-specialist doctors available, for further survival of patient and to relieve symptoms and proper care.

3. After hearing learned counsel for the applicant and learned Addl. PP for the State assisted by Sh.S.S.Kler, Advocate for complainant and after going through reports as submitted by the concerned doctor of Jail Superintendent as well as opinion of Dr. Adish Goyal, who gave opinion after checking the medical record of the applicant-accused, this court is of considered view that the applicant-accused Gurdeep Singh is being given proper treatment for his ailment and tests have also been

conducted and as per report of concerned doctor the applicant-accused was facing Gastritis and not cardiac chest pain as alleged by the applicant. So far opinion of independent doctor is concerned as alleged by counsel for the applicant, he only perused the medical record pertaining to accused/applicant whereas on the other hand the experienced doctor of Government Rajindra Hospital, Patiala has not only clinically as well physically got tested the accused-applicant and after his admission in the hospital for about 6 days they have given detailed opinion above mentioned. As such, the application in hand in these facts and circumstances carried no weight in it and same is hereby declined. Jail authorities are directed to do the needful in future as and when required as per Punjab Jail Manual Rules. Papers be attached with the main trial file.
