This is an application u/s 482 of B.N.S.S. filed by the petitioners namely, Biswanath Pradhan and another in c/w Kharagpur(L) P.S Case No.356/2026 dtd 27.04.2026 u/s. 85/117(2)/3(5) BNS.

Ld. advocate for the petitioner/petitioners submitted that no bail application has either been filed before any Higher Court or any such bail petition has been rejected.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioners submits that these petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case. Ld. Advocate for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners are the father in-law and mother in-law of the complainant's daughter and the allegations against them are general in nature. Therefore, they pray for anticipatory bail on any terms and conditions.

Ld. P.P. in-charge produces the case diary and leaves the adjudication of the case to the discretion of the Court by pointing out the matters available in the case diary.

Heard the Ld. Advocate and Ld. P.P. in-charge.

Perused the petition, CD and other materials in case record.

Prima facie, it appears that there are insufficient incriminating materials against these petitioners and the allegations against them are general in nature. Considering the materials available on record, in my opinion custodial detention for the purpose of interrogation of the petitioners is not necessary. Hence, prayer for anticipatory bail is considered and allowed.

In the event of arrest the petitioners named above may find bail of Rs.2,000/- each with 2 sureties of Rs.1,000/- each subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting officer and with usual condition as laid down u/s 482(2) B.N.S.S.

Misc case is disposed of. CD/TCR, if any, be returned.
