Today stands fixed for hearing of the instant Criminal Misc. Case. C.D. is produced.

The record is now taken up for hearing.

This is an application u/s 438 of Cr. P.C. filed by the applicant namely, **Kishore Hembram @ Raju** in connection with **Nayagram P.S. Case 20/2010 dated 23.04.2010 u/s 302/34 of I.P.C. & 27 of Arms Act** and G.R. Case No.279/2010.

At the very outset Ld. Advocate for the applicant submits that no application for bail of the accused/applicant has either been rejected by the Hon'ble High Court Calcutta or is pending for disposal before the Hon'ble High Court Calcutta or any other higher forum.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the applicants who submits for bail on the ground that investigation is over. He further submits that other co-accused are already on bail on the same footing. He also submits that it is a long pending case of the year 2010. He has fixed place hearth and home. Ld. Advocate also files an affidavit in support of his every contention. As such prayer for bail may be allowed on any terms and conditions.

Ld. P.P. raises objection but also admits that investigation is over.

Perused the C.D., L.C.R. Considered.

Perusing the C.D., L.C.R. and other materials on record it appears from the record that this is a case of the year 2010 arisen out of Nayagram P.S. Case No.20/2010 in which Ld. Sessions Judge on previous occasion has been pleased to grant bail two another accused persons in Crl. Misc. Case No.146/2019 vide order dated 05.12.2019 u/s 438(2) of Cr. P.C. It further appears from the record that C.S. has already been submitted in this case showing completion of the investigation and no further detention of the accused person is not at all required in this case. Moreover, there is no prayer for the side of prosecution that further investigation of the case is going on and I.O. may take the accused persons for custodial interrogation as per the order of court.

Hence, the applicant namely, **Kishore Hembram @ Raju** may find bail of Rs.2,000/- with two sureties of Rs.1000/- each subject to the satisfaction of Ld. ACJM, Jhargram.
