Plaintiffs, defendants and their respective counsels are present.

Both the plaintiffs and defendants have filed Compromise Petition U/o 23 Rule 3 R/w Section 151 of CPC and prayed to record compromise as per compromise petition.

The contents of compromise petition are read over to the plaintiffs and defendants in Kannada Language known to them. They have stated that they have agreed for the compromise voluntarily and accordingly signed the compromise petition. They have also admitted the contents of the compromise petition to be true and correct.

It reveals that both the parties have entered into compromise and reduced the terms of compromise into writing as per compromise petition. The terms of compromise petition are not against the provisions of Indian Contract Act or public policy. I am satisfied that the compromise is voluntary and lawful.
