Today stands fixed for hearing of the instant Criminal Misc. Case. C.D. is produced.

The record is now taken up for hearing.

This is an application u/s 483 of B.N.S. filed by the applicant namely, **Goutam Pal @ Bittu Pal** in connection with **Lalgarh P.S. Case 51/2026 dated 21/04/2026 u/s 85/109/3(5) of B.N.S. & adding Sec.108 of BNS.** and G.R. Case No.407/2026.

At the very outset Ld. Advocate for the applicant submits that no application for bail u/s 483 of BNSS of the accused/applicants has either been rejected by the Hon'ble High Court Calcutta or is pending for disposal before the Hon'ble High Court Calcutta or any other higher forum.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the applicant who submits for bail on the ground he is in custody since 21/04/2026 being arrested. Marriage took place 12 years back. Relying upon the forwarding report he contends that at best this is the case of suicide. He further submits that this accused is FIR named but the allegations are false and concocted. He also submits that other co-accused has already been enlarged on bail vide Crl. Misc. Case No.98/2026 dated 22.05.2026. He further submits that lastly on 20.05.2026 bail application of this applicant has been refused by Ld. ACJM, Jhargram. He also submits that this applicant is the local resident so there is no chance of his abscondance. Prior to death no complaint was lodged. He is ready to face the trial as such prayer for bail may be allowed on any terms and conditions.

Ld. P.P. raises objection. He refers the BHT contained in page no.67 to 88 and also refers page no.11 of the C.D. He also points out the statements of witnesses recorded u/s 180 of BNSS contained in page nos.13, 23, 24, 25 & 27 of the C.D. He refers the inquest report and P.M. Report contained in page no.101 and 103 respectively.

Perused the C.D. & L.C.R. Considered.

From the page no.11 it apparently seems to me this might be a case of suicide but considering the gravity of the alleged offence material in the C.D. and period of detention I am not inclined to allow the application for bail at this stage. Accordingly prayer for bail of this applicant is **refused**.
