Ld. District PP is present and Ld. Lawyer for the accused is also present.

Today has been fixed for recording of evidence of prosecution witnesses I.e Dr. Pranab Ray who conducted PM examination and I/O of this case.

Accused persons are absent by petition.

Ld. District PP has submitted that today the doctor could not appear before the Court as because he is seriously ill and accordingly, he verbally prayed for adjournment.

Considering the facts and circumstances, prayer for adjournment is considered and allowed for Dr. Pranab Ray.

It further appears from the submission of Ld. District PP that Dr. Pranab Ray is a resident of Kharagpur which is 55/60 Kms from Jhargram and in this situation being ill Court cannot ask him to come to depose and instead of that his evidence may be recorded through video conference and accordingly, Superintendent of Police, Jhargram is requested to make necessary arrangements for recording of evidence through video conference of the witness Dr. Pranab Ray.

Ld. District PP has further drawn the attention of the Court that Dr. Pranab Ray does not have either laptop or smart mobile phone with him and accordingly necessary arrangement be made through which he can attend video conference at **10:30AM on 05/03/2026.**

The Officer-in-charge, Trial Monitoring Cell, Jhargram who is GRO of this case is also directed to take necessary instructions from Superintendent of Police, Jhargram for arrangement of video conference for recording the evidence of Dr. Pranab Ray, being ill.

ASI rank officer or SI may be deputed for arrangement of video conference for recording the evidence of Dr. Pranab Ray as observed above.

A copy of this order be sent to Superintendent of Police, Jhargram and Officer-in-charge, Trial Monitoring Cell, Jhargram.

Superintendent of Police, Jhargram is further requested to direct PSI Anjan Kumar Maity, I.O of this case either to remain personally present before the Court

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on 05/03/2026 or to record his evidence through video conference whichever his choice and convenience.

Officer-in-charge, Trial Monitoring Cell, Jhargram is further directed to send the scanned copy of case diary or the case diary itself including statements, seizure lists etc so that the I/O can conveniently depose before the Court in order to avoid any observation of the case and regarding delay of the case.

This is a case arisen out of Jamboni PS Case No. 16/2012 dated 25/04/2012 u/s. 498A/306/34 IPC and charge-sheet has been submitted against the accused persons and the case record is more than about 15 years and accordingly as per the direction of Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta (Hon'ble Arrears Committee) the record is to be disposed of in a time bound manner without granting any unnecessary adjournment to either of the side.
