Today has been fixed for further evidence of the prosecution witnesses.

Ld. PP-in-charge is present and Ld. Lawyer for the accused is also present.

It appears from the record that all the three accused persons on court bail are present by taking step.

Today has been fixed for further evidence of S.I Ramesh Saha which was last recorded on 15/11/2019 and his examination-in-chief is still deferred.

Ld. Public Prosecutor has submitted that since then several times summons were issued to the said witness but he did not turn up before the Court on various pretext and accordingly his evidence could not be recorded.

It further appears from the order No. 61 dated 29/08/2025 that vide order No. 60 dated 13/08/2025 Md. Golam Gasul, S.I of Police Jangipur Police District and S.I. Ramesh Saha again prayed for time for their appearance and accordingly Superintendent of Police, Jhargram was requested to ensure the presence of Inspector Ramesh Saha along with other witnesses and for the said reason the previous schedule was cancelled on the prayer of Ld. Public Prosecutor, Jhargram.

It was further observed by the Court considering the conduct of the witnesses in order No. 61 dated 29/08/2025 that there was miscommunication in between Trial Monitoring Cell and Prosecution in bringing witnesses before the Court resulting into futile exercise and accordingly Superintendent of Police, Jhargram was requested for sensitizing the Monitoring Cell, Jhargram.

Further, I would like to mention that this case has arisen out of Jhargram Women PS FIR No. 16 of 2017 dated 05/03/2017 in which charge-sheet was submitted on 31/05/2017 u/s. 498A/302/201/34 IPC and u/s. 3 and 4 of the D.P Act but till today due to above acts and deeds of the stake holders.

The Court has been able to examine only six witnesses. The Court is also in dark as to why Inspector of Police Ramesh Saha is not appearing before the Court.

Accordingly, ADG, Headquarter, Bhabani Bhaban, Kolkata is being controlling authority of the Inspector is requested to take appropriate disciplinary action against Inspector Ramesh Saha in this regard.

Superintendent of Police, Jhargram is also requested to ensure the appearance of Inspector Ramesh Saha and other witnesses of this case in consultation with Ld. Public

Prosecutor of the district and to pass necessary instructions to Trial Monitoring Cell in this regard.
