Today stands fixed for hearing of the bail petition.

The record is now taken up for hearing and Order.

Ld. lawyer for the accused is appointed by D.L.S.A., Jhargram, who moves the instant bail petition.

Copy served. Ld. P.P. in-Charge is present.

Ld. Defence Counsel submits that initially the case was under Section 394 of the I.P.C. and subsequently, Section 413 of the I.P.C. was added on 12/10/2022. He further submits that C.S. has already been submitted on 01/11/2022, and the co-accused has already been enlarged on bail after 2 months in detention. As such, his prayer for bail may be considered on any terms and conditions.

Ld. P.P. in-Charge raised objection.

Perused the case record and other materials therein and on perusal of the same, this Court considers that the co-accused enlarged on bail is on the same footing as the present accused petitioner and also considers the period of detention of the accused person, **Soumen Dutta** in J/C, and feels that further detention will not serve any purpose. As such, the prayer for bail of the petitioner **stands allowed**.

Hence it is

ORDERED

that the accused/petitioner, namely, **Soumen Dutta**, may find **bail of Rs.5000/-, with two registered sureties of Rs.2500/- each, one of whom must be local**, subject to satisfaction of the ld. C.J.M. Jhargram, **and the accused is not to leave the jurisdiction of the concerned P.S., and shall be present before this Court on each and every date fixed, and further directed not to intimidate nor tamper with the evidence in any way**, failing which this Order shall be automatically cancelled.

Let a copy of this Order be sent to ld. C.J.M., Jhargram for information.

Accordingly, **bail application is disposed of**.
