The record is put up today by the prayer of Petitioner-02.

Copy served. Petitioner-02 filed a prayer for preponment of the date of order.

The prayer is considered and allowed.

Petitioner No. 1 namely, Smt. Susmita Singha and Petitioner No. 2 Sri Partha Pratim Sinha are present by filing haziras being assisted by their respective representatives.

The record is now taken up for order.

Seen the evidence on record as adduced by petitioner no.1 and petitioner no. 2. respectively.

After considering the contents of the original application filed by the parties in this case and the evidence adduced by them, it is found that the marriage between the parties was solemnized on 19.03.2023 according to Special Marriage Act, 1954. After their marriage petitioner No.1 went to her matrimonial home i.e. the house of petitioner No.2 at village Ramgarh under P.S. Lalgargh and they led their conjugal life. They have also disclosed that they are living separately since 19.07.2024.

Both the petitioners by swearing affidavit affirmed that due to differences amongst themselves. They could not adjust amongst themselves and thus started living separately from each other and all efforts of reconciliation went in vain and it is absolutely impossible for them to live together as husband and wife and consequently, they agreed to dissolve their marital life.

The unchallenged testimony adduced by the petitioners on oath established their contention made in this case. Further assertion of the parties also established that they were living separately and preceding the instant petition.

Considering the said testimony of the parties and their voluntariness, I find that there is no possibility of reunion and therefore, the parties are entitled to get an order, as prayed for.

Hence, it is,

Ordered

that the instant Matrimonial Suit No. 252/2025 be and the same is decreed on contest but without any cost.

The marriage between Susmita Singha and Partha Pratim Sinha on 19.03.2023 vide Certificate No. WB34400310020100102432-2023-25321 stands dissolved u/s 28 of the Special Marriage Act, 1954 with effect from this date by a decree of divorce on their mutual consent.
