Today the date is fixed for charge.

Accused person namely, Rahul Dutta appears through his Ld. Advocate along with a petition praying for pleading guilty.

The petition filed on behalf of the accused person namely, Rahul Dutta is pleading for guilty is taken up.

Ld. APP who raises no objection.

Upon submission by Ld. Advocate for the accused that he intends to plead guilty before his court and also a petition is filed stating that the accused person is willing to plead guilty. Upon perusal of the CR, it is found that there is reasonable ground to presume that the accused person has committed the offence.

The accused is found to have submitted voluntarily and with free consent. On being satisfied, regarding the voluntary admission of guilt by the accused person they are found guilty and hereby convicted.

Hence it is.....

“ORDERED”

The accused person Rahul Dutta is found guilty for commission of offence punishable u/s 46 A(c) of Bengal Excise Act and hereby convicted u/s 246(3) Cr PC.

The accused person namely, Rahul Dutta is hereby sentenced to undergo simple imprisonment of 1 day (till rising of the Court) and pay fine of Rs. 1,000/- in default of payment of which he is to suffer further simple imprisonment for 15 days.

If the fine is paid, then the period of detention already undergone be set off against the sentence of imprisonment awarded u/s 428 Cr.P.C.

The case is accordingly disposed of.
