Today the case record is fixed for evidence of CSW 1 and 2.

No S/R is received.

Regular P.O is on leave.

The accused person namely, Susanta Ghosh is present by filing hazira along with a petition praying for pleading guilty.

The petition filed on behalf of the accused person namely, Susanta Ghosh is pleading for guilty is taken up.

Ld. APP is present and raised no objection.

The substance of accusation under section 279/304A of Indian Penal Code is read over and explain to the accused person in Bengali and he is asked whether he plead guilty or not. The accused person after hearing and understanding the substance of accusation pleaded guilty by saying “Ami doshi” in Benagli and they further stated when asked that he is pleading guilty voluntarily on his own volition without any coercion and after understanding the nature and consequences of pleading guilty.

Accordingly, the accused person namely, Susanta Ghosh is found guilty of offences committed U/S 279/304A of Indian Penal Code.

Considering the age of the record and the financial condition of the accused person

Hence it is

“O R D E R E D”

That the petition for pleading guilty is allowed and the accused person namely, Susanta Ghosh is convicted u/s 252 Cr.P.C for offences u/s 279/304A of Indian Penal Code. Hence the accused are directed to pay a fine of Rs. 500/- for the offence U/S 279 of IPC and the accused is directed to pay a fine of Rs. 2500/- for the offence U/S 304A of IPC, that is total of Rs. 3000/-, I/D Simple Imprisonment of 30 days, to be effected consecutively.

Seized articles to be returned to the convict after due verification if any.

A copy of this order to be given to the convict free of cost.

Thus, the instant case record is disposed of.
