**Application to enlarge on Regular Bail under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagrik
Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (Section 439 of the Criminal Procedure Code)**

Order below Exh.1.

1. The present bail application has been preferred by the applicant-accused seeking regular bail in connection with the offence registered vide FIR being C.R.No.11191011260145 of 2026 with DCB Police Station, Ahmedabad punishable under Sections 8(c), 20(b)(ii)(B), 29 of the N.D.P.S. Act, 1985 on the grounds so particularized in the application.

2. The brief facts of the complaint is such that total quantity of 01 Kg and 975 grams of contraband substance "Hybrid Ganja" along with other muddamal worth Rs.79,67,500/- was recovered from the conscious possession of the accused, during the raid conducted by the police as per the secret information received by the DCB Police, Ahmedabad and upon inquiry, it was found that it was transported from Rajasthan at the instance of present accused from other co-accused namely (1) Pradeep

Rajendra Kalal, Manpreet and other co-accused who are absconding. Hence, FIR was registered against the applicant-accused.

3. It is averred that the applicant is innocent and has been falsely roped in the alleged offence on the basis of disclosure statements. It is submitted that the present applicants-accused were arrested in the alleged offence and produced before the Learned Chief Metropolitan Magistrate Court at Ahmedabad and presently are in judicial custody since 25-05-2026. It is further submitted that the applicant is not having any past antecedents or criminal history. The applicant shall not try to abscond and will also not try to tamper with any evidence or witnesses and will abide by the conditions that would be so imposed by the Court, if the applicant is released on regular bail. Thus, in view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the applicant urged to release on regular bail by granting the present bail application.

4. Notice was duly served to the other side. The Learned APP appearing on behalf of the State has vehemently objected the application and produced an Affidavit filed by the I.O. vide Exhibit-7, wherein it is submitted that total total quantity of 01 Kg and 975 grams of contraband substance "Hybrid Ganja" along with other muddamal worth Rs.79,67,500/- was recovered from the joint conscious possession of the accused and other co-accused, during the raid conducted by the police as per the secret information received by the DCB Police, Ahmedabad and upon inquiry, it was found that it was transported from Rajasthan at the instance of present accused

from other co-accused namely (1) Pradeep Rajendra Kalal, Manpreet and other co-accused who are absconding. It is also stated that the investigation qua present accused is in progress. The charge-sheet has not been filed against the accused. If the applicant is released on bail, there is possibility of repetition of offence and applicant may flee away from justice. Considering the gravity of offence, it is requested to dismiss the present bail application.

5. Heard learned advocates for both sides. I have gone through the contents of the bail application together with the records and proceedings of the case. As per the case of the prosecution and as per the affidavit reply filed by the investigating agency, it transpires that the applicant is involved in serious offence punishable Section 8(c), 20(b)(ii)(B), 29 of the N.D.P.S. Act, 1985 for transporting/selling trading/purchasing the illegal contraband substance “Hybrid Ganja” along with other muddamal worth Rs.79,67,500/- and was recovered from the conscious possession of the accused, during the raid conducted by the police as per the secret information received by the DCB Police, Ahmedabad and upon inquiry, it was found that it was transported from Rajasthan at the instance of present accused from other co-accused namely (1) Pradeep Rajendra Kalal, Manpreet and other co-accused who are shown as “absconding”. The accused is knowingly indulged in illegally transporting, importing of narcotic drugs without pass/permit.. The alleged narcotic substance i.e. “Hybrid Ganja” having intermediate quantity of 01 Kg and 975 grams which is prohibited under the NDPS Act, 1985. The applicant is arrested

on the basis of investigation on 25-05-2026 and the investigation qua the accused is in progress. Such investigation is at crucial stage. In light of the above discussion, and having considering the citations submitted by the Learned Advocate for the applicant, at this stage, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the applicant. Consequently, I pass following order in the interest of justice as under :-

ORDER

1. The present application filed by the applicants for releasing on **Regular Bail**, is hereby **rejected**.
2. Yadi of this order be issued to the concerned authorities accordingly through e-mail.
