Order dated 24.06.2025:

Today is fixed for appearance and necessary Order.

De facto complainant is present along with her Ld. Advocate.

Charge-sheet named accused persons represented through their Ld. Advocate by filing hazira.

Ld. APP is present.

Record is taken up for passing of Order in respect of Narazi petition submitted by the de facto complainant on 06.11.2023.

In this case the I/O after completion of investigation has charge-sheeted three accused persons, namely, Argha Roy, Asit Roy and Tanuja Roy under Section 498A/323/506/34 of IPC r.w.s. 3/4 of the D.P.Act. Three other accused persons, namely, Pinki Nag, Bapi Mondal and Piu Mondal are not sent up. This Court had discharged those accused persons who are not sent up as per the materials in the charge-sheet. However, the de facto complainant subsequently appeared before the Court and filed narazi petition against the charge-sheet submitted by the I/O and in the said Narazi petition, it was alleged that the I/O has not conducted proper investigation. At the time of hearing it was submitted that the discharged accused persons has played important role in inflicting mental torture to the de facto complainant and they have even threatened the de facto complainant over phone and other social media account.

To give an opportunity of hearing following the requirements of natural justice, this Court had issued notice upon the discharged accused persons to appear before this Court and place their views on record. In respect of the narazi petition filed by the de facto complainant but even after such notice none had appeared on behalf of the discharged accused persons.

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Continued Order dated 24.06.2025:

The charge-sheet named accused persons were present before the Court on previous occasions at the time of hearing and even today their Ld. Advocate is present before this Court. No particular objection is raised by the Ld. Advocate of the accused persons in respect of the Narazi petition filed by the de facto complainant.

Having considered the contents of the written complaint which was treated as FIR, the materials available on C/D and the assertions made in the narazi petition by the de facto complainant, it would be best in the interest of justice if an order for further investigation is made in this case.

The petition dated 06.11.2023 under Section 173(8) of Cr.P.C. made by the de facto complainant is **allowed**.

Accordingly, I/O is directed to conduct further investigation in this case and submit supplementary charge-sheet, if any, after proper investigation.

Inform the I/O.

GRO to do the needful.

Fix **11.11.2025** for appearance and submission of further investigation report by I/O.
