The case is fixed for further proceedings. Today, learned
counsel for the decree holder has made the following statement:

‘Stated that as per information furnished by the judgment debtors through an affidavit, their assets and properties from which the award passed in favour of award/decreed holder can be satisfied are situated outside the jurisdiction of this court and the State of Haryana. So, on the instructions of the decree holder, I withdraw the present execution petition with liberty to file a fresh execution petition before the court of competent jurisdiction where the property of judgment debtors are situated. It is also requested that stamp duty affixed on the present execution petition be also refunded as award has not been satisfied and the decree holder will have to affix requisite stamp duty as per the law while filing the fresh execution petition.’

Heard. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the decree holder, the present execution petition filed by the decree holder stands dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for. Stamp duty affixed on the execution petition be also refunded to the decree holder. Certificate for refund of stamp duty be also issued in favour of decree holder as per rules against proper receipt and identification. File be consigned to record room after due compliance.
