At this stage the parties have shown their willingness to resolve their dispute amicably and this court is of the view that there are chances of settlement between the parties. Learned counsel for both the parties have also shown their willingness. They have taken the parties in confidence and they are ready to amicably settle their dispute if some solution is found.

It has been made clear to the parties and their counsel that the mediation proceedings shall be conducted by a trained mediator and the parties have also right to exhaust remedy to resolve their dispute under section 89 CPC before Mediator. However, if no settlement is arrived between the parties before mediation centre then they have the remedy to settle the dispute through legal process of law.

As per provisions of Section 89 of the Code of Civil Procedure, separate referral order has been dictated. The signatures of parties with their counsels be obtained as per rules. Parties are directed to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre at Kurukshetra today at 2.00 PM.
