01.	08.01.2026	<u>HN, J</u> The petitioner is the State Tourism Development Corporation, which is aggrieved by the impugned order dated 19.11.2025 issued by the 3rd respondent, calling upon the petitioner to remove the alleged violative construction in the premises referred to in the said speaking order. It is submitted that the issue of violation of Coastal Regulatory Zone (CRZ) regulations was dealt by the Division Bench of this Court in W.P.(PIL).No.53 of 2024 and batch and the Division Bench of this Court had categorically directed the respondents to issue notices containing the details of violations committed by the said entities. It was further observed that the said entities may also be granted personal hearing apart from submitting their explanation. It is submitted that the impugned proceedings dated 19.11.2025 would categorically indicate that no show cause notice calling upon the petitioner to submit	Contd.,

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		explanation was ever issued. That apart, the speaking order merely refers to the service agreement entered into by the petitioner and there is no detail as to what exactly is violation which, according to the 3rd respondent, are required to be removed. Learned Standing Counsel appearing for the 3rd respondent submits that the 3rd respondent has issued similar notices to other entities who have constructed in violation of the CRZ regulations. Considering the submissions, the matter would require further consideration. Evidently, the 3rd respondent has not issued any show cause notice calling upon the petitioner to submit its explanation with regard to the said violations. On these considerations, the speaking order dated 19.11.2025 issued by the 3rd respondent shall stand suspended. This Court has considered W.P.No.33664 of 2025, the submission of the respondents that the batch of writ petitions including W.P.(PIL).No.53 of 2024 are pending before the Hon'ble Division Bench of this Court and the proceedings arising out of the interim orders passed in W.P (PIL) No.53 of 2024 ought to be heard	Contd.,
