may be pleased to issue a Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondents in threatening to dispossess the petitioner from the lands in Sy No 7/7 to an extent of Ac 1.47 Cents situated at Nallarallapalle Village, Santhipuram Mandal, Chittoor District, without notice and without acquisition, as illegal, arbitrary and unconstitutional direct the respondents not to dispossess the petitioner from the subject lands except by following due process of law

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased may be pleased to direct the respondents to maintain status quo as on date in respect of the land in Sy.No.7/7 to an extent of Ac. 1.47 cents situated at Nallarallapalle Village, Santhipuram Mandal, Chittoor District, and consequently restrain them, their officials, agents or anybody claiming through them from laying any road, dumping material or interfering with the petitioner's possession in any manner whatsoever, pending disposal of the writ petition and pass

The Court made the following Order:

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Assistant Government Pleader for the respondents.

2. This writ petition was filed questioning the action of the respondents in threatening to dispossess the petitioner from the lands in Sy.No.7/7 to an extent of Ac.1.47 cents situated at Nallarallapalle village, Santhipuram Mandal, Chittoor District without notice and without acquisition.

3. On the other hand, the learned Assistant Government Pleader relying upon the written instructions of the 4th respondent dated 05.01.2026 submits that the respondent Nos.2 to 4 are not interfering with the petitioner's land situated in LPM No.215 (old Sy.No.7/7) in an extent of Ac.1.45 cents and not taken any steps to dispossess the petitioner.

4. In view of the above said facts and circumstances, recording the instructions of the 4th respondent dated 05.01.2026, no further orders are necessary in this writ petition.

5. Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of. The written instructions of the 4th respondent dated 05.01.2026 shall be made as part of the court record. Interim order, if any, deemed to have been vacated. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel, Miscellaneous Petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
