The Court made the following ORDER :-

"The learned Public Prosecutor has taken notice for respondent Nos.1 & 2 and requests time to obtain instructions.

Issue notice to respondent No.3.

The learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.3 by registered post with acknowledgment due and file proof of service by the next date of hearing.

Post on 15.02.2023.

The petitioners are Accused Nos.2 to 6 in C.C.No.539 of 2022 on the file of Judicial First Class Magistrate, Salur, for the offences under Section 498-A r/w Section 34 of Indian Penal Code and Sections 3 & 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961.

A perusal of the charge sheet does show that there are no specific allegations against the petitioners except general and omnibus allegations of harassment.

In the circumstances, the presence of petitioners shall be dispensed with for the trial, till further orders in C.C.No.539 of 2022 on the file of Judicial First Class Magistrate, Salur, except when they are required for examination."
