The petitioners are accused in C.C.No.562 of 2014 on the file of the Additional Judicial First-Class Magistrate Hindupur, Anantapuramu District, for the offence under Section 498-A & 506 r/w. 34 of Indian Penal Code and Sections 3 & 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act. The petitioners contend that the allegations made against them in the charge	

		sheet are general and omnibus allegations without any details as to specifics and as such, no case can be made against them. A perusal of the charge sheet does show that there are no specific allegations against the petitioners except general and omnibus allegations of harassment. In the circumstances, the presence of the petitioners shall be dispensed with, till further orders in C.C.No.562 of 2014 on the file of the Additional Judicial First-Class Magistrate Hindupur, Anantapuramu District, except when their presence is required for examination.
