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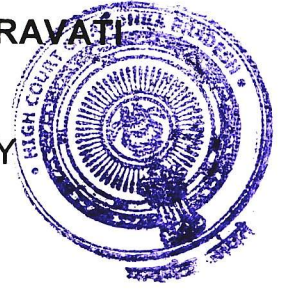

Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondents in not responding in time on the complaint given by the Petitioner regarding burial of a dead body in the road margin as illegal, unlawful and arbitrary and in violation of guidelines issued by Government of Andhra Pradesh in G.O.Nts.No.1235, dated 25.10.2008 and in consequence _ thereof direct the

Respondents not to convert the road margin in RS.No.345/1 and 345/2 into a new burial ground, in addition to existing burial ground.

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondents to take timely action in case anyone intended to burry or cremate the dead body in the road margin in Survey No.345/1, 345/2 of Chinamamidipally village upon receipt of the information is given to the respondents, Pending disposal of WP 705 of 2023, on the file of the High Court.

The petition, coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and the earlier order of the High Court dated.22.12.2025 made herein and upon hearing the arguments of SRI S V R SUBRAHMANYAM Advocate for the Petitioner, GP FOR REVENUE for Respondent Nos.1, 2 , 3 & 5, Sri M.Manohar Redddy Standing Counsel for respondent No.4, the Court made the following.

ORDER

“This Court, *vide* proceedings dated.22.12.2025, directed the respondent authority to conduct survey, in the presence of the petitioner, to resolve the dispute, within a period of four (04) weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this Order.

Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue placed written instructions dated. 04.02.2026.

On perusal of written instructions, Respondent No.4/Tahsildar sought two more weeks to conduct survey.

Permission is granted.

Respondent No.4 is directed to conduct survey within a period of three (03) weeks from today.

List the matter after four (04) weeks."
