ORDER:

Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee is directed to issue necessary proceedings in this regard.

The Station House Officer concerned/the learned Trial Court shall drive the parties to the mediation.

Both the parties shall appear before the mediation on 06.05.2026.

In case, if any of the Petitioners are not able to attend the mediation, they are at liberty to attend the mediation virtually.

The learned mediator shall file his report within one week thereafter.

Until the mediation proceedings are concluded, there shall be stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.404/2024 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Kalyanadurgam.
