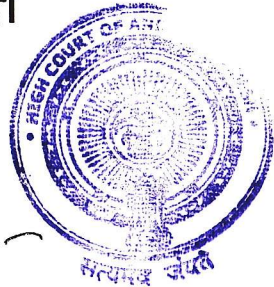

WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his/her Advocate Sri T V SRI DEVI presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court

may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction one in the nature of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondents 2 to 7 in identifying the land belonging to Public Health Center, Nathavaram Village and Mandal, Anakapalle District for the purpose of construction of Volley Ball court without calling for objections, without following the procedure under BSO 22 of Andhra Pradesh Board of Revenue Standing Orders is illegal, arbitrary and violative of Article 14 and 21 of Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents 2 to 7 not to make construction of Volley Ball court in the land belonging to PHC, Nathavarm Village and Mandal, Anakapalli District and pass

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri T V SRI DEVI Advocate for the Petitioner, GP for Medical & Health for Respondent Nos. 1, 3 and 7, GP for Panchayat Raj for Respondent No.5, directed issue of notice to the Respondent Nos. 2,4 & 6 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
