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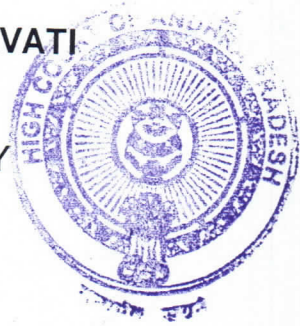

Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or direction under Article 226 of constitution of India more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the proceedings in Ref.No.C1/1069/2024 dated 12.12.2024 issued by Respondent No.3 with respect to fair price shop no. 1035030 in Kakarakayalapalli is arbitrary, illegal and contrary to the well-established legal principles and principles of natural justice apart from being violative of the fundamental and Constitutional rights guaranteed to me under Articles 14,19 (1) (g) and 21 of the Constitution of India and consequently set aside the same.

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to continue me as the Fair Price Shop dealer by granting interim suspension of proceedings in Ref.N0.CI/1069/2024 dated 12.12.2024 issued by respondent No.3 with respect to fair price shop no. 1035030 by Respondent no 3.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri HARSHITHA G. S., Advocate for the Petitioner, GP FOR CIVIL SUPPLIES for the Respondent Nos.1 to 6 and the Court made the following.

ORDER:

“The learned Assistant Government Pleader for Civil Supplies appearing for the respondents requested time to get instructions.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been serving as a dealer of the fair price shop on temporary basis for about 24 years. However, a vacancy has now been suddenly

declared, and a notification was issued. A test was conducted on 28.12.2024, but the result was not declared. Therefore, the learned counsel requested to pass interim direction not to declare result till the next date of adjournment to enable the writ petition to be disposed of on merits.

Post the matter on 03.02.2025.

Till then, the respondent authorities are directed not to declare result of the subject fair price shop.

In the meantime, the learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to submit documents showing the petitioner's eligibility and criteria."
