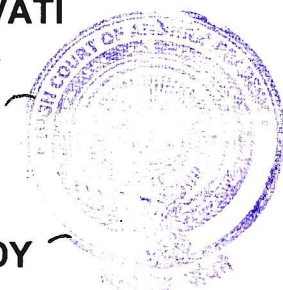

WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI DEVARA ESWARA RAO presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order

Direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, Issue a Writ of Mandamus Directing Respondents 2 and 3 to establish and operationalise a full-fledged CSD Canteen / CSD Extension Counter in Vizianagaram District Headquarter, Andhra Pradesh, within a time-bound schedule. To Direct Respondents to ensure that ex-servicemen, widows, dependants, and serving soldiers of the region are provided uninterrupted CSD facilities without forcing them to travel long distances. To Direct Respondents 2 and 3 to submit a status report on action taken on previous representations tiled by the District Ex-Servicemen Welfare Office, Vizianagaram.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri DEVARA ESWARA RAO Advocate for the Petitioner, Additional Solicitor General of India for Respondent No.1 to 4, directed issue of notice to the Respondent Nos.3 &4 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

Notice before admission, returnable in three (3) weeks.

Issue notice to respondent Nos.3 and 4.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent Nos.3 and 4 by registered post with acknowledgment

due and file proof of service before the Registry within a period of three (3) weeks.

List the matter after three (3) weeks.
