The Petition coming on for hearing and upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein support thereof and the earlier order of the High Court dated 30.03.2026 made herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri MANGENA SREE RAMA RAO Advocate for the Petitioner, and of M/s KAVITHA GOTTIPATI, Advocate for the Respondent, the Court made the following

ORDER:

Learned counsels on both sides submit that the parties are ready and willing to resolve their disputes amicably through the process of mediation.

2. Considering the submissions advanced and after perusing the material on record, and since the dispute is matrimonial in nature, we are of the view that, at this stage, the parties shall appear before the Mediation Centre of this Court for an amicable settlement.

3. Let the parties appear before the Andhra Pradesh High Court's Mediation Centre on 07.05.2026, which shall be the first date of mediation session.

4. The Mediation Centre shall appoint a mediator. The mediator shall fix the dates for holding sessions, and after completion of the mediation proceedings, submit a report within three (03) months from the date of first session.

5. Post the matter after receipt of report of the learned mediator.

6. Interim order granted earlier dated 30.03.2026 is extended till the next date of hearing.

7. Let the copy of this order be sent to the mediation centre of this Court with the particulars of this case.

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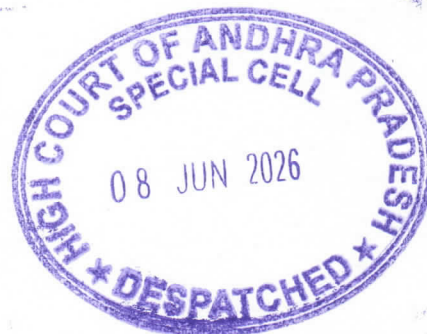
