01.	10.04.2026	<u>Dr.VJP,J</u> <u>I.A.No. 01 of 2026</u> The present interlocutory application was filed under Section 438 (1) of BNSS, 2023 by the petitioner to suspend the conviction and sentence dated 15.02.2021 passed in C.C.No.147 of 2017 on the file of learned I Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Tenali, which was confirmed vide Judgment dated 17.02.2026 passed in Crl.A.No.48 of 2021 on the file of learned XI Additional Sessions Judge, Tenali and enlarge the petitioner/accused on bail, pending disposal of the main Criminal Revision Case. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor on behalf of the State. In view of the submissions made, the sentence of imprisonment alone is suspended, pending disposal of the Criminal Revision Case on the following conditions: i) The petitioner herein is directed to surrender before the learned I Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Tenali, within two weeks from this day and, on such surrender, the petitioner shall be enlarged on bail on executing a personal bond for	

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		a sum of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only) with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the learned I Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Tenali, on the same day. ii) The petitioner shall deposit 50% of the cheque amount before the learned I Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Tenali, within a period of two (2) weeks from this day. Any amount already deposited shall be given due credit. In default of deposit of cheque amount, as ordered supra, the interim suspension granted today, shall stand cancelled automatically without further reference to the Court. iii) The petitioner shall appear before this Court as and when directed. <u>Crl.R.C.No.390 of 2026</u> Admit. Issue notice to the respondent No.2. Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to the respondent No.2/complainant through Speed post/courier and file proof of the same.
