List the matter after three weeks".

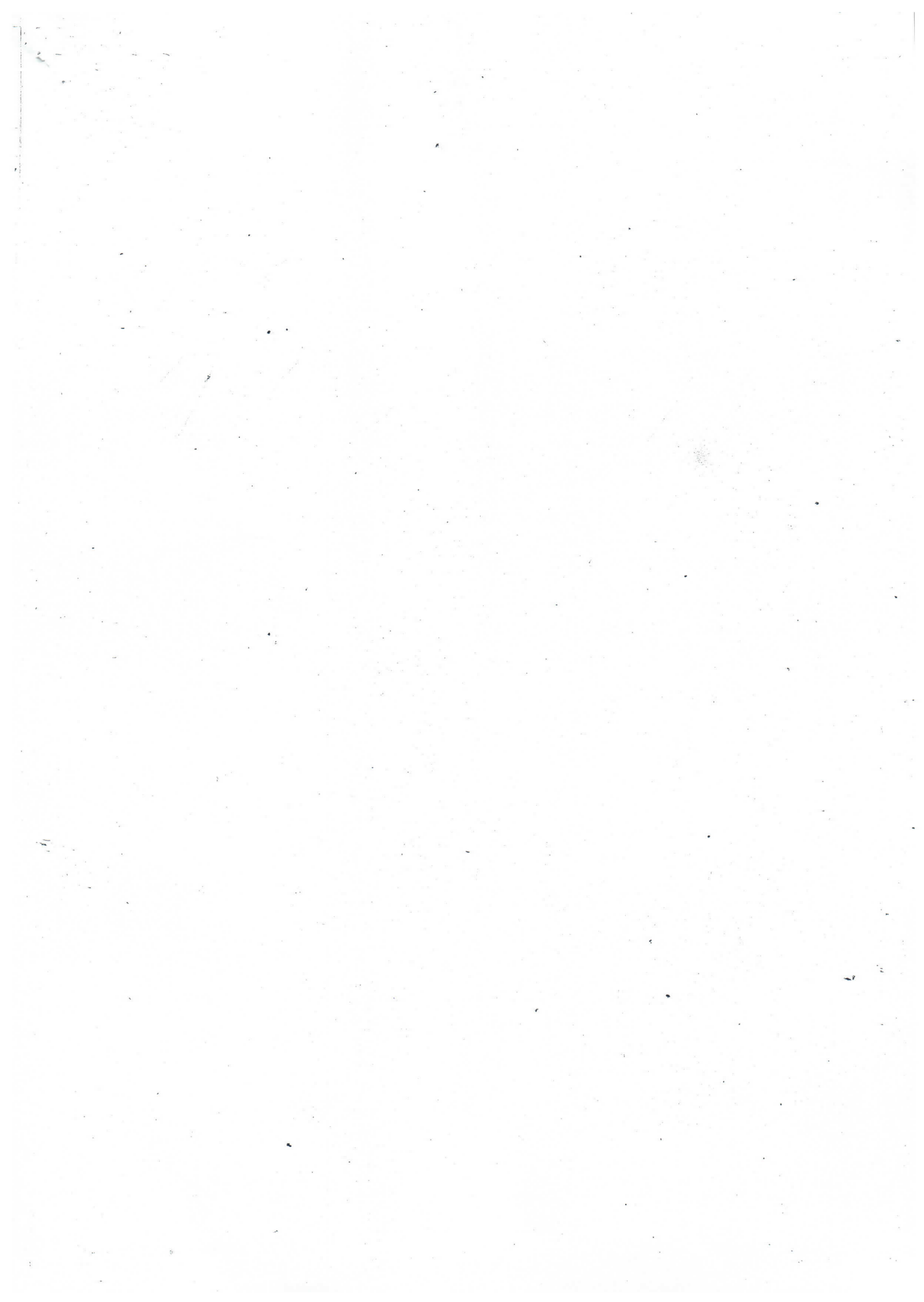
