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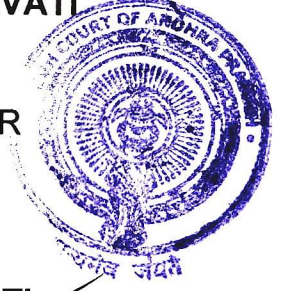

Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an order, writ or direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondents in non-compliance of FTR Number 8080421000460 Dated. 16.04.2021 an Amount of Rs.6,17,550/- and FTR Number 8080421000418 Dated. 16.04.2021 an Amount of Rs.3,33,920/- comprising in total Amount of Rs.9,51,470/-(Rupees Nine Lakhs fifty one thousand and four hundred seventy Only) due to the petitioner with interest of 24% in respect of work ID No. 087044204004090052 pursuant to the work executed vide Construction of New sachivalayam and wellness center and Rithu Bharosa Kendram in Petlur Gram Panchayat of Kondepi Mandal as illegal, arbitrary and in violation of Article 14 of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents to pay an amount of Rs.9,51,470/- (Rupees Nine Lakhs fifty one thousand and four hundred seventy Only) due to the petitioner with interest in respect of execution of afore mentioned works forthwith.

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents to take steps for paying the amount of Rs.9,51,470/- (Rupees Nine Lakhs fifty one thousand and four hundred seventy Only) due to the petitioner with interest, Pending disposal of WP 1594 of 2025, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI SHAIK MEERAVALI Advocate for the Petitioner, GP FOR PANCHAYAT RAJ RURAL DEV for the Respondent Nos.1 & 3 to 5, GP FOR FINACE & PLANNING for respondent Nos.2 & 6, Sri M.Sudhir Standing Counsel for respondent nos.7 & 8, the Court made the following.

ORDER

The petitioner is claiming certain amount for the works executed by him and the 9th respondent is also claiming the said amounts. It was brought to the notice of this court that the 9th respondent has made a representation to the concerned authority requesting not to pay the amounts to the petitioner. ✓

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner reported no objection for conducting such an enquiry on the representation made by the 9th respondent. ✓

3. In view of the facts and circumstances of the case, it resolve the issue of who is entitled for payments of amount, as an interim measure, this Court is inclined to pass the following direction: ✓

The District Panchayat Officer concerned is directed to pass orders on the representation made by the 9th respondent by duly hearing both the petitioner and the 9th respondent in accordance with law.
