Secretary High Court Legal Services Committee is directed to issue necessary proceedings in this regard.

The Station House Officer concerned/the learned Trial Court shall drive the parties to the mediation.

Both the parties shall appear before the mediator on 06.05.2026.

The learned mediator shall submit his report as early as possible.

Post after Summer Vacation, 2026.

Until the mediation proceedings are concluded, there shall be stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.533/2023 on the file of the learned I Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Chittoor.”
