Petition under Section 528 of BNSS is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to quash the proceedings in FIR. No. 46 of 2022 dated 27.05.2022 on the file of CID Police Station, Amaravathi, Mangalgiri, Guntur District against the petitioners / Accused 1 & 2 and grant such other relief or reliefs as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the circumstances of the case.

Petition under Section 528 of BNSS is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further proceedings in the FIR.No.46 of 2022 dated 27.05.2022 on the file of CID Police Station, Amaravathi, Mangalgi, Guntur District including arrest and personal appearance of the petitioner, Pending disposal of CRLP No.476 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and the earlier order of the High Court dt. 15.04.2026 made herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Raja Manuri Venkata Sumanth, Advocate for the Petitioner, and of Public Prosecutor for the Respondent No.1, the Court made the following.

ORDER

Heard learned counsel for Petitioner and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

The Inspector General Police, CID, A.P. Mangalagiri vide proceedings C.No. 1070/C12/CID-AP/2021 dated 15.01.2023 accorded permission to delete the accused No.9, who is the Chief Manager of UCO Bank, after coming to know that he has not played any role in obtaining fake or false fabricated documents for sanctioning loan to the accused. Surprisingly, on 12.02.2026, the present Director General of Police, CID vide proceedings C.No. 1070/C12/CID-AP/2021 dated 12.02.2026 passed an order accorded permission to reinstate the accused No.9 as per investigation made in the reference.

Therefore, the opinions of the Director General of Police, CID are changing from time to time depending on the person who is occupying the positions.

The present and past Director General of Police, CID shall appear before this Court along with relevant record.

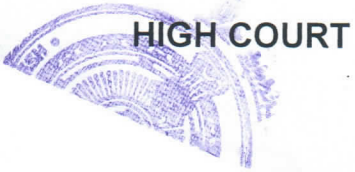
