

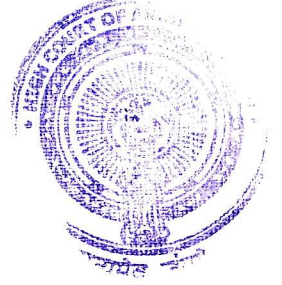

Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of MANDAMUS declaring the action of the respondents in seeking to dispossess the petitioner from the land over an extent of Ac 1.00 cts in Sy.No.13/2 situated at Bayyanapalli Village, Gangavaram Mandal, Polavaram District in pursuance of the notice in Ref.B/225/2025, dt 19.11.2025 as wholly

illegal, arbitrary and unjust and consequently direct respondents not to dispossess the petitioner from the above land by setting aside the notice issued by the 4th respondent, in the interest of Justice.

IA NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay of all further proceedings in pursuance of the notice in Ref.No.B/225/2025, dt: 19.11.2025 including dispossession of the petitioner from the land over an extent of Ac 1.00 cts in Sy.No. 13/2 situated at Bayyanapalli Village, Gangavaram Mandal, Polavaram District, Pending disposal of WP 2229 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and the earlier orders of the High Court dated: 02.02.2026, 23.02.2026 & 10.03.2026 made herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri K VENKATESH, Advocate for the Petitioner and of GP FOR TRIBAL WELFARE, for Respondent Nos.1 to 3 and of GP FOR REVENUE, for Respondent Nos.4 & 5 and the Court made the following;

ORDER:

1. The impugned proceedings were issued seeking to evict the Petitioner pursuant to the orders passed in L.T.R.P No.29 of 2005, dated 13.11.2007.
2. This Court after hearing the learned counsel for the Petitioner had directed the Respondents to produce the copy of L.T.R.P.No.29 of 2005, dated 13.11.2007 *vide* orders dated 02.02.2026. However, the said order was not produced even today.
3. Learned Assistant Government Pleader passed on a letter issued by the Tahasildar, Gangavaram Mandal, Polavaram District, wherein it was mentioned that the order copy is being searched in the files of the Special Deputy Collector, Tribal Welfare, Rampachodavaram.
4. Considering the same, post on 24.06.2026.
5. Interim order granted earlier is extended until further orders.
